We require an enthusiastic Teacher of Pupil Support to join the Department, which consists of one Principal Teacher and one Teacher. Applicants must be well-qualified graduates with sound communication and time management skills. They must have a comprehensive knowledge of the curriculum and, ideally, experience in supporting pupils with a range of varying and complex needs too. Applications will be welcomed from experienced teachers who express an interest in working within Pupil Support. Applicants must be GTC Scotland registered and also PVG registered, prior to taking up post.

Salary is based on SNCT Pay Agreements. In addition, a QVS Boarding School Allowance is payable to reflect the requirement to undertake additional boarding duties. Currently, this allowance is £7,752. Please be advised that the Department is conducting a review of all pay related allowances which could impact on those allowances that the post currently being advertised attracts. A commitment to boarding school life, including taking part in extracurricular activities, is essential. Previous experience in sports coaching, Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme or CCF would be desirable.
